


Week 1—Planting Seeds



Chenille stems, paper, crayons


Activity: Create a sculpture of chenille stem roots holding a picture at the top and names or pictures of people who support them at each base.

Boxes, cans, plastic bottles, containers, beans, rubber bands, rice


Activity: Make instruments from recycled and found items
